#### 1. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

St. Francis Xavier Pre and Primary School

#### 1.1. THE DIOCESE OF SINGIDA

The Catholic Diocese of Singida is a typical missionary area in Tanzania. It was established on 16<sup>th</sup> December 1972 and presently under the leadership of Bishop Edward Mapunda. It is located in central Tanzania. The population in the whole area is about 1,086,748 of which only 166,460 are Catholics. It has only 28 parishes scattered in an area of some 49,345 sq. km of largely dry and semi – arid region with minimal annual rainfall ranging only between 500mm – 800mm.

The people in the diocese are mainly substance peasants and semi – nomadic herdsmen who main economic activity is traditional farming, growing mainly drought resistance crops – sorghum, millet, maize and sunflower, thus earning less than a dollar per day and therefore living on an average per capital income below US 140. The above atmosphere suggests the inability of the diocese to finance all her pastoral activities including education of the people found within the diocese.

#### 2. BRIEFLY HISTORY OF CONGREGATION

The Missionaries of the Precious Blood is a congregation found by St. Gaspar de Buffalo in 1815. In Tanzania, Missionaries of the Precious Blood came in 1966 and started the first mission at Manyoni Singida diocese. Later 1972 started the new mission at Itigi.

#### 2.1. PROBLEM IDENTIFICATION

The population of Itigi which increases with a rate of 50% per year brings concern. The government alone cannot manage to enroll all children due to fewer schools which are found within Itigi town and vicinity. For this reason Missionaries of the Precious Blood due to their spirituality of cry of blood found themselves obliged to respond to this need.

Most of the children especially from vulnerable environment and poor family in Itigi Parish are unable to achieve good education due to lack of primary schools within the area and most of the families are very poor thus earning less income than a dollar per day hence they unable to afford education expenses for their children.

### 2.2. PROJECT OBJECTIVES/GOALS

- To support children who live in vulnerable environment as well as poor family have better and safe environment for their learning activities.
- To construct four classrooms at Primary school that will accommodate 180 students/pupils.



- To contribute to the development efforts and the demand of primary education in Tanzania.
- To improve education serves in Itigi society by providing quality education.
- To reduce the school fees compared to other schools.

#### 2.3. PROJECT ACTIVITIES:

The Project will be supervised and handled carefully and diligently according to the schedule after having received the money.

- Reduction of poverty in the society particularly Itigi Area; when these children are educated well, they become productive members of these poor family through employment / self-employment.
- Improvement of living standard of Itigi society.

#### 3. PROJECT MANAGEMENT

The project will be managed by Fr. Dominic E. Mwaluko Cpps who is the Provincial Treasure of the Precious Blood Tanzania together with Fr. Patrick Athanas Kimaro C.pps as the in charge of the school (school Manager at St. Francis Xavier Pre & Primary school). The school will arrange and implement preliminary preparation, acquisition of materials for construction of four classrooms, transportation, monitoring and evaluation as well as report writing to the donor on time.

#### 4. MONITORING AND EVALUATION

Monitoring will be carried out from the beginning of the planned activities and will be continuous process done by FR. Dominic E. Mwaluko C.pps who is the Provincial Treasure of the Precious Blood Tanzania to ensure effectiveness and efficiency of the work done.

Evaluation will be jointly done by FR. PATRICK ATHANAS KIMARO who is the School Manager at St. Francis Xavier Pre and Primary School and a Missionary of Precious Blood. The work will base on the stated supposition/ assumption that will determine the objectives have been attained about completion of the project.
